Sub-Aqua can pose a pressure-related risk to the lungs, sinuses and/or ears. Also, there is an inherent risk of panic which can cause serious injury or, in the very worst case, death. Whilst Skegness Aquarium promotes the 'diving for all' approach, there are some considerations to factor in when dealing with participants aged 16 or younger. The human body develops at differing rates from one individual to another. Skegness Aquarium works closely with the British Sub Aqua Club (BSAC) to develop a minimum age bracket for all experiences. This minimum age bracket allows participants to enjoy activities from the age of 6 and 11 for the BSAC Shark Snorkelling Ranger Experience or 10 and above for the BSAC Shark Educational Dive.

When making such a decision it is important to consider the comfort levels of the participant(s) when in water. The use of breathing apparatus can cause a claustrophobic sensation in rare cases, this sensation can be heightened by a child with unsuitable emotional readiness. Both the BSAC Shark Snorkelling Ranger Experience and the BSAC Shark Educational Dive are conducted in **Salt Water** with temperatures ranging from 22°C to 28°C which cannot be avoided due to animal welfare obligations.
